1. PUBLIC TRANSPORT

As no parking at or near the stadium will be available to the public, concertgoers are encouraged to use public transport to and from the stadium. Extra event-related public transport will supplement the usual services and Metrorail has arranged for additional trains on **selected lines** to run after the event. This will ease the anticipated high traffic flows and ensure that fans arrive on time and are able to get home after the event.

1.1 RAIL

Any person commuting on any Metrorail train on any route to the concert and return journey, being in possession of valid concert ticket may travel free of charge. All persons not in possession or able to produce the required valid concert ticket will be charged the full normal fare for the journey.

Normal train services will be applicable before the concert with an additional train from Bellville via Monte Vista to Cape Town.

1.2 EVENT SHUTTLE(S)

1.2.1 CIVIC CENTRE/STADIUM

- 1st bus from the Civic Centre bus station in Hertzog Boulevard depart at 17:00
- Bus will leave every 15 minutes or when full
- Last bus will leave the Stadium bus station in Western Boulevard at 00:15
- CHARGES: Free of charge on presentation of a valid concert ticket.

1.2.2 HOUT BAY

- 1st bus departs from Kronendal Primary School (Hout Bay) at 17:00, stops at Maiden's Cove (Camps Bay) to Main Road, Green Point opposite York Road.
- A bus will leave every 30 minutes or when full.
- The last bus before the concert leaves Hout Bay at 20:30 and there will be no service during the concert.
- The first bus after the concert will leave around 23:00 from Main Road, Green Point opposite York Road.
- The last bus back to Hout Bay will leave at 00:15.
- CHARGES: The shuttle is free of charge on presentation of a valid event ticket.
- PARKING is available at:-
 - Kronendal Primary School at R20 per vehicle entry.
 - Maiden's Cove free parking is available on Victoria Road or in the municipal parking area off street in Victoria Road.
- SECURITY GUARDS will be deployed at Kronendal Primary School and the off street parking areas in Victoria Road.

1.2.3 UNIVERSITY OF CAPE TOWN (UCT) – UPPER CAMPUS, RONDEBOSCH

- 1st bus departs from UCT at 17:00 to the Civic Centre bus station in Hertzog Boulevard.
- A bus will leave every 15 minutes or when full.
- The last bus before the concert leaves UCT at 20:30 and there will be no service during the concert.
- The first bus after the concert will leave around 23:00 from the Civic Centre bus station.
- The last bus back to UCT will leave at 00:30.
- CHARGES: Free of charge on presentation of a valid concert ticket.

1.3 EXTENDED MYCITI CIVIC CENTRE TO TABLE VIEW SERVICE

The MyCiTi service between Civic Centre and Table View bus stations has been extended to accommodate concertgoers. This will be an express service and will not stop at any of the stations between the Civic Centre and Table View bus stations.

PRIOR to the concert, fans will be required to purchase the normal MyCiti ticket to travel to the Civic Centre bus station.

AFTER the concert, fans will be able to use the service free of charge on presentation of a valid concert ticket stub. The bus will depart from the Civic Centre bus station at 00:00 and the last feeder services will depart from the Table View bus station at 00:30.

1.4 PARK-AND-RIDES

Park-and-Rides are generally situated near or at rail stations along the Cape Town – Bellville (via Monte Vista), Cape Town – Strand (via Goodwood), Cape Town to Heathfield (via Ottery) and Cape Town – Fish Hoek lines. Security will be present from 17:00 until after the last train has left the station. Members of the public can park their cars and travel by rail to the CBD from the following areas:-

3. IMPACT OF ROAD CLOSURES ON PUBLIC TRANSPORT SERVICES

Public transport services that, for any portion of their routes, operate along closed or restricted roads may have some route section deviations. Normal scheduled bus services will be affected by these road closures in the Green Point area as well as the CBD from 14:00 on 5 October 2011.

The affected services in the different areas, as well as their rerouting, are listed below:

3.1 BUS SERVICES TRAVELLING THROUGH THE GREEN POINT AREA

All services along Somerset/Main Road Green Point between Buitengracht and York Road will run along Western Boulevard. Passengers using this service may board or disembark at the stops either side of the closures at Buitengracht or York Road.

3.2 BUS SERVICES ENTERING THE CBD

The Waterfront service will operate via the CTICC, turning right into Heerengracht, stopping opposite Standard Bank, proceeding around the circle, back down Heerengracht and on to the Waterfront.

The Waterfront/Sea Point service will continue to operate on its normal routes but may be subject to slight delays.

3.3 MYCITI BUS SERVICE

The normal Civic Centre/Waterfront MyCiti bus service will **not** be free of charge to concert ticket holders.

The MiCiti service will not stop at the Stadium and Granger Bay bus stations but will be rerouted turning right into Portswood Road from Western Boulevard, left into Beach Road and right at the traffic circle into Granger Bay Boulevard.

During this time the Stadium bus station will be used for event services only.

Granger Bay bus station will be closed for this period while all other stops and services on the F1 Waterfront route will operate as per schedule.

Passengers may use the Waterfront (in Breakwater lane) and/or Buitengracht stops as alternatives to the Granger Bay and Stadium bus stations.

On the return journey from the Waterfront, the bus will turn left into Beach Road, right into Portswood Road and left at Western Boulevard to continue its normal route to the CBD.

4. PARKING

Parking restrictions will be enforced in residential areas adjacent to Cape Town Stadium from 00:00 to 24:00 (midnight) on 5 October 2011. Motorists are advised to obey the signage.

Limited parking is available for private vehicles in the stadium precinct. Parking tickets are available online from Computicket via the following link:-

The parking ticket will reflect the parking area and concertgoers must follow the directional temporary road signage that corresponds to the parking area on the ticket e.g P10.

4.1 PEOPLE WITH DISABILITIES

Dedicated parking has been allocated on DF Malan Drive for those concertgoers with disabilities who wish to use the Stadium shuttle. Only people with an official disability permit from the City will be allowed to park in this dedicated parking area.

There is no charge for the limited disabled parking at the stadium in parking area P5 within the stadium precinct (which is located off Vlei Road). These tickets can be obtained on request by emailing Donne Luddick at Big Concerts (donne@bigconcerts.co.za). Please note that you will be requested to provide proof that you have a legitimate disabled permit or a letter from your doctor indicating the need for such a parking space. *Disabled Parking access is issued at the discretion of Big Concerts and subject to availability.*

4.2 COACHES

Requests for coach parking can be e-mailed to Donne Luddick at donne@bigconcerts.co.za before close of business Friday 30th September 2011.

4.3 DROP-AND-GO

Concert goers may be dropped off and collected in DF Malan Drive opposite the Artscape Theatre or dropped off on Western Boulevard (seaside carriageway) between Vlei Road and the elevated circle.

4.4 ON STREET IN THE CBD

On street parking is available within the CBD but no additional security will be provided. Parking tariffs will apply until 18:00 when on street parking becomes free of charge.

4.5 V&A WATERFRONT

The V&A Waterfront has approximately 3,500 parking bays available to the general public. There is a charge associated with this parking, and traffic flows into and out of the V&A Waterfront may be congested.

4.6 VIP PARKING

VIP parking ticketholders must access the stadium via Beach Rd, show their parking tickets, turn into Granger Bay Boulevard and enter parking area P2 at the Fort Wynyard circle. No other entrance is available for VIP parking.

5. PEDESTRIAN ROUTES

The Fan Walk provides the opportunity for concertgoers to move between the Civic Centre bus and Cape Town rail stations to the stadium at Green Point along a dedicated pedestrian route. Roads down the fan walk will be closed from 17:30. A contra-flow system will be provided for local vehicle access on the mountain side carriageway on Main Road in Green Point between York and De Smit Streets.

6. CYCLING

Concertgoers wishing to ride to the stadium are encouraged to do so. Racks for locking your bicycle are located on the eastern (Waterfront) side of the elevated circle at the stadium. Cyclists must provide their own lock and chain as bicycles are left at own risk. Please remember the “ridesafe” motto and wear a helmet, have adequate lighting and wear reflective clothing. (**NB: helmets are not allowed inside the stadium.**) Bicycles are left at your own risk. Due to the number of people using the Fan Walk, it is advised that cyclists coming from the CBD use the route through the V&A Waterfront or the back roads in De Waterkant to access the stadium.
